

Sewage Rates and Billing

Billing:

Applications for new service may be made in person at the Authority office or by downloading the form from the website and mailing.

Sewage bills are sent to the property and not the individual. Therefore, landlords and not tenants are ultimately responsible for unpaid bills. Purchasing a property with outstanding bills or a municipal lien does not relieve the current owner of the charges.

Customers are billed monthly unless they are located in an area where a billing agreement has been established with the Authority.

Bills are mailed on or as close to the 15th of each month. If your bill may become lost, you are still responsible to make payment in a timely manner. Due dates are noted on the bill as well as late charges and fees imposed after the due date. The due date is on or near the 5th of each month. The bill represents service for the previous month.

Note: Under no circumstances is credit given for the filling of swimming pools or other large volume uses without a deduct meter. Large use due to leaks, will be addressed on a case by case basis, however, please realize that not all "leaked" water can or will be credited.
